Directions to Horse Show Grounds

From Washington - Take Rt. I-66 West to Warrenton/Gainesville Exit - Rt. 29 South. Go approximately 9 miles to Rt. 674, Georgetown Rd. (first road after traffic light at Rt. 600), turn right. Go approximately 1.2 miles and turn left on Rt. 694, Old Bust Head Road. Go approximately 1 mile onto dirt section (stay right at "Y" on Old Bust Head). Approximately 2/10th mile at top of rise, turn right into Laughing Fox Farm.

From Winchester - Take Rt. 50 East to Rt. 17 South at Paris, then onto Rt. I-66 East to Warrenton exit to continue on Rt. 17 S. Approaching Warrenton follow signs to Rt. 29N. Go approximately 4 miles and turn left on Rt. 674, Georgetown Rd. Go approximately 1.2 miles and turn left on Rt. 694, Old Bust Head Road. Go approximately 1 mile onto dirt section (stay right at "Y" on Old Bust Head). Approximately 2/10th mile at top of rise, turn right into Laughing Fox Farm.

From Fredericksburg - Via 95 North of Fredericksburg, exit Rt. 17 North. Follow Rt. 17 to Route 29 North. On North side of Warrenton, go approximately 4 miles and turn left on Rt. 674, Georgetown Rd. Go approximately 1.2 miles and turn left on Rt. 694, Old Bust Head Road. Go approximately 1 mile onto dirt section (stay right at "Y" on Old Bust Head). Approximately 2/10th mile at top of rise, turn right into Laughing Fox Farm.

From Culpeper - Rt. 29 North. On North side of Warrenton, go approximately 4 miles and turn left on Rt. 674, Georgetown Rd. Go approximately 1.2 miles and turn left on Rt. 694, Old Bust Head Road. Go approximately 1 mile onto dirt section (stay right at "Y" on Old Bust Head). Approximately 2/10th mile at top of rise, turn right into Laughing Fox Farm.

Rules And Regulations

OFFICE FEE. A \$ 10.00 Office Fee will be charged per horse pony entered.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS. Every class offered herein, covered by the rules and regulations of the current Short Circuit, BHSA and VHSA Rule Books will be conducted and judged accordingly. The Judge's decisions are always final.

ENTRY FEES. \$14.00 per class. VHSA Medal \$25.00 per class. Best Child Rider \$5.00.

SCHOOLING. Will be permitted only in designated schooling areas. Schooling available from 6:30-8:00 a.m. prior to the show. All Juniors must have an adult oversee schooling.

COGGINS TEST. All exhibitors must present a Negative Coggins Test report taken within one year on each animal exhibited. This is a Virginia State Law.

EXHIBITORS. All exhibitors must wear ASTM/SEI certified helmets at all times while mounted on the showgrounds with harness secured. Proper attire and equipment expected; jackets may be excused at Judges discretion.

AWARDS. Six ribbons per class. Champion and Reserve Champion trophies and ribbons in all divisions. Points scored 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, ½ for show championships, Short Circuit, BHSA and VHSA Associate award programs.

RESPONSIBILITIES. The Winslett Advantage, Deb and Doug Fisher, their officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, spectator, rider, guest, groom attendant or other employee, animal or equipment at the show. The show reserves to itself the right to decline to accept any entry and return any entry fees before or during the show without being liable for compensation; to change location, combine, cancel, split or limit any classes; or change any officials.

DOGS. All Dogs must be on leashes while on the showgrounds.

VHSA Division Specifications

VHSA Children's, Adult Amateur, Pony Medals: Open only to regular members of the VHSA. Riders to compete over a regulation equitation course at appropriate heights: 3' for Children's, Adult Amateur and Large Pony, 2'6" for Medium Pony, 2'3" for Small Pony. In Pony Equitation at least 12 to return for the flat. In Children's and Adult Amateur Equitation at least the top 4 riders must have additional tests. See VHSA Rule 14.

Short Stirrup Hunter: Open to horses and ponies ridden by children 12 years and under. Neither riders nor mounts may cross enter into any division or class where they would jump higher than 18". Jumps 18". May trot or canter over fences. Riders limited to not more than two mounts in the division.

Short Circuit: Leadline (3 classes), Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation, Beginner Equitation, Young Entry Equitation, Pony Pleasure, Horse Pleasure, VPBA Pony Hunter, Small/Medium Pony Hunter, Large Pony Hunter, Green Pony Hunter, Children's and Adult Amateur Hunter 2'6" & 3', Pony Equitation, Children's Equitation 2'6" & 3', Adult Amateur Equitation 2'6" & 3', Student Equitation, Green Hunter, Limit Rider Hunter.

Battlefield Horse Shows Association: Leadline (1 class), Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation, Short Stirrup Equitation, Pony Pleasure, Horse Pleasure, Schooling Hunter, Working Hunter, Green Hunter, Children's and Adult Amateur Hunter 2'6" & 3', Small/Medium Pony Hunter, Large Pony Hunter, Green Pony Hunter, Pony Equitation, Children's and Adult Amateur Equitation 2'6" & 3'.

VHSA Associate Program: Green Hunter, Working Hunter, Children's Hunter, Adult Amateur Hunter, Small/Medium Pony Hunter, Large Pony Hunter, Pony Pleasure, Horse Pleasure, Green Pony Hunter, Pony Equitation, Children's Equitation. Adult Amateur Equitation, Short Stirrup Hunter.

For Membership and Horse Recording forms and information for these Associations, see the Show Secretary. Each Association has annual high score awards in the above listed categories, which are presented at a year-end banquet.

All Hunter Classes to be judged on performance and soundness, with emphasis on maners and suitability in pony, children's and adult amateur. Over fences classes not to jog.

All Equitation Classes to be judged on hands, seat guidance and control.

BHSA Division Specifications

Leadline. Open to children 7 years and younger as of 12/1/10. To be judged 50% suitability of mount and 50% rider's equitation. Riders not allowed to cross enter into any class where they would be asked to trot.

Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation. Open to riders 10 years and under as of 12/1/10. Riders not allowed to cross enter into classes where they would be asked to canter or jump.

Short Stirrup Equitation. Open to riders 12 years and under as of 12/1/10. Jumps may not exceed 18". Riders not allowed to cross enter into classes where they would jump over 18".

Working Hunter. Open to all horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Jumps 3', 3' 3". May be combined with Schooling Hunter.

Adult Amateur Hunter, Children's Hunter, Small/Medium Pony Hunter, Large Pony Hunter, Pleasure Pony, Pleasure Horse – See Short Circuit Specifications.

Low/Schooling Hunters. Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Low Hunter to jump 2', Schooling Hunter to jump, 2'6".

Green Pony Hunter. Open to ponies (14.2 hands and under) in their first year of showing over fences, including pleasure and equitation classes over fences at or above 2' for Small Ponies, 2'3" for Medium Ponies and 2'6" for Large Ponies as of 12/1/10, ridden by juniors. The Green Pony division may be combined with the Green Hunter if less than 3 ponies and/or Green Hunters entered.

Green Hunter. Open to horses in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2'6" or higher including pleasure and equitation classes as of 12/1/10

Short Circuit Division Specifications

All Riders ages of 12/1/10.

Leadline. Riders 6 years and under. Rider not eligible for any other classes and must not have competed in any class other than Leadline. Rider to be led at the walk. Pony to be led at all times. Classes to be judged on rider's equitation, and pony's suitability and manners as a leadline mount, as specified.

Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation. Riders 9 years and under. Not eligible for any classes where rider would be asked to canter or jump. Must not have ever competed over fences or at the canter at any show. Properly attached anti-grazing reins acceptable. May not cross enter in any other equitation class.

Beginner Equitation. Riders 11 years and under. May cross-enter into Pleasure and Short Stirrup. Must not have shown over jumps over 18" at any show. May trot or canter over fences. May not cross enter in any other equitation class except Short Stirrup Equitation.

Student Equitation. Riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing at 2' or higher. Jumps not to exceed 2'. May cross enter into Pleasure and other divisions where jumps not over 2', but not any other equitation class. Must not have shown at other shows jumping higher than 2'. May trot or canter over fences and simple changes allowed.

Young Entry Equitation. Riders 12 years and under. Jumps 2'. May cross-enter into Pleasure and other classes where jumps not over 2'. Must not have shown at other shows higher than 2'. May not cross-enter into Pony, Student or Junior Equitation class.

Junior, Pony, Adult Amateur Equitation. Junior riders and Adult Amateur riders. Small ponies to jump 2', Medium ponies to jump 2'3", Large Ponies to jump 2'6" and Horses to jump 2'6" or 3' over a course of at least 8 fences. At least ¼ to return to hack. In Pony Equitation only junior riders. Over fences phase to count 50%, flat phase 50%.

Best Child Rider. Year-end award presented to the junior whom, in the opinion of the judges throughout the series is the most accomplished rider showing in one or more performance divisions. Riders to be identified by wearing armband throughout the day. The judge will identify the rider only to the show manager who will forward the decision to the Short Circuit Committee for compilation with the other shows' results and presented at the Banquet. Judged on who best exemplifies characteristics required for outstanding horsemanship/equitation.

Horse Pleasure. Open to horses ridden by juniors and adults. Judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners and suitability. To be split Adult and Junior Pleasure if entries warrant.

Pony Pleasure. Open to Ponies ridden by juniors. Judged same as Horse Pleasure.

Pony Hunter. Open to Small Ponies not over 12.2 hands to jump 2', Medium Ponies over 12.2 but not over 13.2 hands to jump 2'3" and Large Ponies over 13.2 but not over 14.2 hands to jump 2'6". Junior riders. If 4 or more Large Ponies and 4 or more Small/Medium Ponies to be split.

VPBA Pony Hunter. Open to ponies registered with the VPBA, exhibited under their registered name and in the name of the last recorded owner or lessee who must be a current member of the VPBA, ridden by juniors. Small/Medium Ponies to Jump 2', Large Ponies to jump 2'6".

Limit Rider Hunter. Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors and adult amateurs who are not entered in any classes jumping 2'6" or higher. These riders are not eligible for AA Equitation, Pony Equitation, or Jr./Children's Equitation. Ponies must be ridden by juniors. Horses/ponies may cross enter into other divisions. Courses to be a minimum of 6 fences set at 2'3".

Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter. Open to horses over 14.2 hands ridden by juniors and horses or ponies not shown in any pony division, ridden by Adult Amateurs to jump 2'6" or 3'. Children's and Adult Amateur to be split if entries warrant.
